

We have studied law and Gospel and 16-plus parables in their light.

- <u>Law</u>: commands, shows our sin, kills us <u>Gospel</u>: promises, shows Savior, saves us
- The parables with sufficient context seem primarily to be told as law, to show sin.
- Many of the same parables arguably were also told as Gospel to believers.
- The Holy Spirit can use parables to proclaim both law and Gospel to us who are sinner-saints.

Does the law-Gospel distinction illumine Matthew 13:10-17?

- Basically, Jesus says believers get the parables and unbelievers do not.
- Unbelievers are themselves to blame for not understanding or perceiving.
- Repentance in a sense is a "turning point" from law to Gospel.
- We are blessed with eyes that see and ears that hear.
