-- Written as a four-stanza hymn, it was published in 2005 with one original stanza omitted.

-- 2005 source gives the following Bible references: Luke 24:1; 1 Corinthians 15:55-57; Isaiah 65:19. (*Lutheran Service Builder* gives other "Related Scripture")

-- *Lutheran Service Book* appears to be the first hymnal to make use of the text.

Tune: Public domain

-- Tune of unknown origin achieved notoriety in November 1742 when new verses lambasted government officials and reportedly caused their downfall.

-- Tune used for a Christmas carol published in 1890. (Unclear if that was Starke's exposure to it.)
